- **.** Description of Incident: Seventeen (17) people including females and children were allegedly killed and thirteenseven (37) others injured in an attack carried by suspected armed militia herders at Azege settlement, Mbaya, Tombo Ward in Logo LGA of Benue State. Several properties including farm produce, farmlands were also set ablaze by the attackers.
- Location: Azege settlement, Mbaya, Tombo Ward in Logo LGA of Benue State.
