Description of Incident: Forty-six (46) people including women and children were reportedly abducted, and several houses were set ablaze in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Gana Town in Zamfara State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

Location: Gana Town in Zamfara State

Casualty [Male&female]: forty-six people including women and children abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and prevent further attacks in the area.
