- o High potential for political destabilisation/instability
- o High number of death (above 20)/major properties damages
- o High number of population affected (inability of the population to cope)
- o Low capacity of the state to respond to it

MEDIUN

o Significant effect on political destabilisation

o Significant reported cases of loss of life (5 to 20) and property o Moderate Capacity of the state to respond to it

• LOW

- o Low effect on Political destabilisation
- o Loss of life (0 to 5)and property destruction not significant o High Capacity of the state to respond
