- Date of Occurrence: 2/2/2025
- 4 Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed a suspected armed bandit, arrested twenty-three (23) other suspects including 4 females, and recovered seven (7) firearms, 80 rounds of live ammunition, 28 cutlasses, 48 daggers and in a security, operation conducted at Angwan Bala Community in Kambari Area, Karim Lamido LGA of Taraba State. 16 motorcycles were also recovered.
- 🖊 Location: Angwan Bala Community in Kambari Area, Karim Lamido LGA of Taraba State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male suspect killed.
- Froperty damaged/Affected population: Several arms ammunition recovered/suspected armed bandits.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects are in the custody of the Nigerian Army for further investigation.
