Title of Incident: ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 26/1/2025

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly arrested a suspected Boko Haram terrorist during a security raid in Bali LGA of Taraba State.

Location: Bali LGA of Taraba State.

Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected terrorist.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect is in the custody of the Nigerian Army for further investigation aimed prosecution.

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly foiled a kidnap attempt, and the victim injured by suspected kidnappers during a security operation at Eiyenkorin Area in Asa LGA of Kwara State.

Casualty [Male&female]: One male injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect is the custody of the NDLEA for further investigation of the crime aimed at prosecution.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Title of Incident: ABDUCTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 27/1/2025

Description of Incident: Five (5) people including a man, his wife and son were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Chikakore Area, Kubwa in Bwari Area Council of Abuja, FCT. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

Location: Chikakore Area, Kubwa in Bwari Area Council of Abuja, FCT.

Casualty [Male&female]: Five people including a female and a child abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security opertaives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Location: Stadium Area in Ogbomoso LGA of Oyo State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Two students killed.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Description of Incident: The operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly intercepted a consignment of 2,000 kilograms of Ghanaian Loud with two suspected drug traffickers arrested during a security raid at Lekki Beach in Lagos Inland LGA of Lagos State.

Location: Lekki Beach in Lagos Inland LGA of Lagos State.

Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: 2,000 kilograms of Ghanaian Loud recovered/suspected drug traffickers recovered.
