Title of Incident: CULT CLASH

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 9/2/2025

Description of Incident: Four (4) people were reportedly killed in a clash between rival cult gangs at Wadata Quarters in Makurdi LGA of Benue State. Supremacy tussle and reprisal attacks have been attributed as the motive behind cult violence.

Location: Wadata Quarters in Makurdi LGA of Benue State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Four people killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members, suspected cultists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested five (5) suspected perpetrators for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

Incident N*2:

Title of Incident: CULT CLASH

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 9/2/2025

Description of Incident: Ten (10) people were reportedly killed in a clash between suspected cultists over levies collection rights from an oil company at Obelle Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State.

Location: Obelle Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Ten people killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members, suspected cultists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command have commenced investigations aimed at apprehending the perpetrators of the crime.

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 9/2/2025

Description of Incident: A Christian cleric was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed robbers at Lubo Community in Yamaltu/Deba LGA of Gombe State.

Location: Lubo Community in Yamaltu/Deba LGA of Gombe State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Christian cleric.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have commenced

Property damaged/Affected population: Several buildings, and a gun truck damaged, two gun trucks stolen/Nigerian Army operatives.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the Nigerian Army have been deployed to strengthen security in the affected area.
