- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Western Nigeria Security Network (WNSN) reportedly killed a suspected kidnapper, arrested two (2) others and recovered 2 firearms in a security operation conducted along Sagamu-Ijebu Ode Road in Odogbolu LGA of Ogun State. Twelve stolen mobile phones, a motorcycle, and a cash sum were also recovered.
- Location: Sagamu-Ijebu Ode Road in Odogbolu LGA of Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male suspect killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected kidnappers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects have been transferred to the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation.
