Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 9/3/2025

Description of Incident: Thirteen (13) people were allegedly killed in a reprisal attack carried out by suspected Lakurawa armed bandits in Birnin Dede Village, Arewa LGA of Kebbi State. Investigation revealed that the reprisal attack occurred following the killing of one of their leaders by security operatives in the area.

Location: Birnin Dede Village in Arewa LGA of Kebbi State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Thirteen people killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives were deployed to forestall further attacks in the area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Title of Incident: ABDUCTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 9/3/2025

Description of Incident: A male resident was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at a residence in Zakirai Village, Gabasawa LGA of Kano State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

Location: Zakirai Village, Gabasawa LGA of Kano State.

Casualty [Male&female]: One male abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
