**Description of Incident:** A Catholic Priest was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang in Oraeri and Akwaeze Villages of Anambra State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** One male abducted.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Catholic priest.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives were deployed to rescue the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
