Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 12/4/2025

Description of Incident: A local vigilante was reportedly killed and two (2) cattle herders injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Gasakpa Community in Abaji Area Council of the FCT.

Location: Gasakpa Community in Abaji Area Council of the FCT.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, two males injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Cattle herders, local vigilantes.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The local vigilantes were deployed to prevent the suspects from rustling domestic livestock in the attack.

Title of Incident: ABDUCTION/RESCUE

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 6/4/2025

Description of Incident: Two (2) people including a female were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Gidan Filoti and Gidan Mairabo Village in Malumfashi LGA of Katsina State.

Location: Gidan Filoti and Gidan Mairabo Village in Malumfashi LGA of Katsina State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two people (1 male, 1 female) kidnapped.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have rescued the abducted victims in a security operation conducted in the area.

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 6/4/2025

Description of Incident: Three (3) people were reportedly killed, two (2) others injured, and several cattle rustled in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Unguwar Doruwa Village in Kankia LGA of Katsina State.

Location: Unguwar Doruwa Village in Kankia LGA of Katsina State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Three people killed, two people injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several cows rustled/Community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims were taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

🚧 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses destroyed/Community residents.

🚧 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army were reportedly deployed to strengthen security in the affected areas and prevent further violence.
