
### SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, and communal clashes including community-herder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

Within the reporting period, a total of 149 armed violence incidents were recorded with 195 injuries and 498 fatalities including 31 women, 10 children and 3 security personnel including local vigilantes. The North-Central and North-West recorded the highest number of fatalities with 410 and 53, while the South-East and South-South accounted for 19 and 7 deaths. Also, the South-West and North-East recorded 5 and 4 deaths respectively in the reporting period. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.



The WANEP NEWS also recorded 24 incidents of kidnapping across 19 States with 163 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 163 kidnapped victims, 11 were women and 4 children. Further analysis reveals that the North-West accounted for the highest numbers with 102, followed by North-Central and South-East with 35 and 17 victims. Also, the South-South and North-East recorded 7, 2 kidnapped victims respectively in the reporting period. The South-West recorded no kidnap victim.

### AFFECTED LOCATIONS




### FATALITIES PER REGION (498)
