**Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 18/5/2025

**Description of Incident:** A female resident was allegedly killed and her husband abducted in an attack carried out by suspected gunmen at Ubuneke-Ivbiaro Community, Owan East LGA of Edo State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

**Location:** Ubuneke-Ivbiaro Community, Owan East LGA of Edo State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** One female killed,one male abducted.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of the police operatives led to the arrest of two suspects in connection with the murder and abduction of the victims.

**Description of Incident:** A banker was reportedly found dead with matchete cuts in an attack carried out by unidenfied assailants after declared missing for days during a security raid in Yaba Area of Lagos State. The motive behind his killing is unknown.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/banker.
