
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, and communal clashes including community-herder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

Within the reporting period, a total of 201 armed violence incidents were recorded with 75 injuries and 233 fatalities including 25 women, 16 children and 14 security personnel. The North-Central and North-West recorded the highest number of fatalities with 94 and 82, while the North-East and South-South accounted for 19 and 17 deaths. Also, the South-West and South-East recorded 11 and 10 deaths respectively in the reporting period. The period under review recorded a decrease in fatalities (233) compared to the period of June 16-30, 2025, with 259 recorded fatalities. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.


The WANEP NEWS also recorded 55 incidents of kidnapping across 19 States with 175 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 175 kidnapped victims, 21 were women, 8 children and 1 security personnel. Further analysis reveals that the North-West and North-Central both accounted for the highest numbers with 74 and 41. Also, the North-East, South-South and South-East recorded 31, 20 and 8 kidnapped victims respectively. The South-West had the lowest figure of 1 victim.


AFFECTED LOCATIONS




FATALITIES PER REGION (233)
