- **Description of Incident:** Eleven (11) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers at Eke Elengbecho Area, along the Otukpo-Otukpa Road in Okpokwu LGA of Benue State. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- 📲 Location: Eke Elengbecho Area, along the Otukpo-Otukpa Road in Okpokwu LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eleven people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Commuters.
