

# **Situation Update** STATISTICS OF INCIDENTS AND FATALITIES IN NIGERIA


#### **SUMMARY**

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, and communal clashes including communityherder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.


Within the reporting period, a total of 203 armed violence incidents were recorded with 143 injuries and 143 fatalities including 5 women, 8 children and 6 security personnel. The North-Central and North-West recorded the highest number of fatalities with 57 and 55, while the North-East and South-West accounted for 15 and 7 deaths. Also, the South-East and South-South recorded 6 and 3 deaths respectively in the reporting period. The period under review recorded an increase in fatalities (143) compared to the period of July 16-31, 2025, with 130 recorded fatalities. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.


The WANEP NEWS also recorded 53 incidents of kidnapping across 20 States with 369 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 369 kidnapped victims, 79 were women, 10 children, and 4 security personnel. Further analysis reveals that the North-West and North-Central both accounted for the highest numbers with 274 and 54 respectively. Also, the North-East, South-West and South-East recorded 25, 7 and 5 kidnapped victims respectively. The South-East had the lowest figures of 4 victims.




## **FATALITIES PER REGION (143)** KIDNAPPING PER REGION (369) 400
