- **Title of Incident: CYBERCRIME/ARREST**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 10/8/2025
- → **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) reportedly arrested ninety-three (93) suspected internet fraudsters during a security raid at a hotel in Itori, Ewekoro Area of Abeokuta of Ogun State. Items recovered from the suspects include two locally made pistols, eighteen vehicles, eighty-nine mobile phones, laptops, and several incriminating documents.
- **Location:** Itori, Ewekoro Area in Abeokuta of Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties recovered/suspected internet fraudsters.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the EFCC for further investigations aimed at prosecution.
