- Description of Incident: Three (3) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Shanga Local Government Area of Kebbi State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Shanga Local Government Area of Kebbi State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Three males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The swift response of the security operatives led to the rescue of the three abducted victims in the area.

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The released 18 people out of the 53 victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Efforts are ongoing by the security operatives to forestall further attacks in the area and apprehend the perpetrataors of the crime.
