- Date of Occurrence: 3/9/2025
- Description of Incident: Several community residents were allegedly killed and others abducted with livestock stolen in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Marnona Axis in Wurno LGA of Sokoto State.
- Location: Wurno LGA of Sokoto State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Several people killed, and several people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/farmers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives were deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators' of the crime.
