- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 17/8/2025
- Description of Incident: A male resident was reportedly killed by suspected armed gang in an attack at Lade Community in Patigi LGA of Kwara State. The reason for the attack is unknown.
- Location: Lade Community in Patigi LGA of Kwara State
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male dead.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There was no reported intervention at reporting time.

- Title of Incident: HOMICIDE
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 17/8/2025
- **♣ Description of Incident:** A male resident was reportedly shot dead by local vigilantes while in their custody following his arrest over an alleged debt at Tilde Fulani Community in Toro LGA of Bauchi State.

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 18/8/2025

- Leave the Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Navy reportedly arrested eight (8) suspects and busted an illegal petroleum products dump in a security operation at Ama-Omu Community in Bonny LGA of Rivers State, seizing approximately 105,450 liters of Automotive Gas Oil (AGO) along with extensive illegal bunkering equipment including plastic tanks, pumping and metering machines, hoses, valves, and other tools. Additional items recovered included walkie-talkies, uniforms of National Hunters and Forest Guards, charms, mobile phones, a blood-pressure monitor, and substances suspected to be marijuana and other drugs.
