- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence:31/9/2025
- Description of Incident: A 52-year-old male resident was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Layi village, Bassa district in Shiroro LGA of Niger State.
- Location: Layi village, Bassa district in Shiroro LGA of Niger State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives were deployed to forestall further attacks in the area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- **Title of Incident: MOB ACTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 31/8/2025
