- Title of Incident: EXTRAJUDICIAL ATTACK
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 12/10/2025
- Description of Incident: An operative of the Nigerian Army reportedly stabbed a businessman to death following an altercation at Otokutu Area in Ughelli South LGA of Delta State.
- Location: Otokutu Area in Ughelli South LGA of Delta State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Businessman.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command commenced an investigation aimed at ascertaining the circumstances surrounding the crime.

Incident N*2:

- Title of Incident: HOMICIDE/ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 12/10/2025
- Description of Incident: A male herder reportedly killed his colleague during a dispute over a debt of at Zakari Forest Reserve in Igboho Area, Oorelope LGA of Oyo State. The suspect allegedly attacked the victim with a cutlass, resulting in fatal injuries. Police operatives swiftly responded and arrested the suspect, recovering the cutlass used in the attack.
- Location: Zakari Forest Reserve in Igboho Area, Oorelope LGA of Oyo State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Cattle herders.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect was detained in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION/BANDITRY
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 12/10/2025
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed several suspected bandits in a security operation conducted at Tungan-Magajiya-Sabongari Road in Rijau LGA of Niger State. An Armored Personnel Carrier (APC) was damaged by the suspects.
- Location: Tungan-Magajiya-Sabongari Road in Rijau LGA of Niger State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Several male suspects dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected bandits.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 12/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Police operatives reportedly foiled a robbery attempt and killed one (1) suspected armed robber during a gun duel at Giri Village in Gwagwalada Area Council of the FCT. Items recovered from the scene include a POS machine, four mobile phones, and a cutlass.

🚩 **Location:** Giri Village in Gwagwalada Area Council of the FCT.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male suspect dead.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected armed robber.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There are ongoing efforts by the FCT Police Command to track down and arrest the fleeing suspects.

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Police operatives reportedly arrested fifty-two (52) suspects during coordinated raids on black spots and criminal hideouts at Nyanya, Gwagwa, Jikwoyi, Utako, Apo, Karmo, Iddo, and Kabusa Areas of the Federal Capital Territory (FCT).

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the FCT Police Command for screening and interrogation for prosecution.

🚩 **Description of Incident:** A police operative was reportedly killed and one (1) other person injured in an attack carried out by suspected cultists at Mosogar Community in Ethiope West LGA of Delta State. The injured victim was taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

🚩 **Location:** Mosogar Community in Ethiope West LGA of Delta State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male security operative dead, one male injured.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Police operative, community member.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command launched an investigation aimed at apprehending the perpetrators.

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 12/10/2025



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🚩 **Description of Incident:** Two (2) police operatives were reportedly injured in an attack carried out by suspected gunmen along Ogobia-Adoka Road in Otukpo LGA of Benue State. The victims were on routine patrol when they came under fire.

🚩 **Location:** Ogobia-Adoka Road in Otukpo LGA of Benue State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two male security operatives injured.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Police operatives.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured operatives were evacuated to the hospital for medical treatment. The State Police Command launched a manhunt for the attackers to ensure their arrest and prosecution.

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 12/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed twelve (12) suspected bandits during a gun battle at Mabai Village in Kankara LGA of Katsina State. Two (2) soldiers sustained injuries during the encounter.

🚩 **Location:** Mabai Village in Kankara LGA of Katsina State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Twelve male suspects dead, two security operatives injured.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected bandits, Suspected bandits.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured operatives were taken to the hospital for medical treatment. There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 12/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** A 20-year-old herder was reportedly abducted following an attack by suspected gunmen on a grazing field at Labau Village in Wuroyanka District, Shelleng LGA of Adamawa State. The assailants also killed thirty-three cattle, injured 6, and rustled eighteen others in the attack. Items recovered from the scene included two arrows, one empty cartridge shell, and one empty AK-47 ammunition shell.

🚩 **Location:** Labau Village in Wuroyanka District, Shelleng LGA of Adamawa State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male abducted.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Thirty-three cows killed, 6 cows injured, 18 cows stolen/Herders.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Local vigilantes and hunters launched a search operation to trace the perpetrators, recover the rustled livestock, and rescue the herder.

🚩 **Title of Incident:** DRUG CONTROL ENFORCEMENT/ARREST

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 12/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested two (2) suspected drug peddlers and recovered 450 bottles of CSP Codeine, 188 bottles of Bargadine, 208 sachets of Tramadol 100mg, 100 sachets of Tramadol 500mg, 300 sachets of Swinol, 50 sachets of



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Rophynol, and a bag of cannabis in a security raid at the Government Reserved Area in Effurun Community, Uvwie LGA of Delta State. Preliminary investigations revealed that the suspects had been in the illegal drug trade for about two years.

The assailants also rustled dozens of cattle in Bogga, Kwadawa, Taiba Badole, Arahiya Kwandawa, Rumawa, Gangara, and Rugar Bindo Communities.

- 🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead, one female injured.
- 🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.
- 🚓 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command launched an investigation and intensified patrols to strengthen security in the affected areas.

- 🚓 **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly rescued nine (9) kidnapped victims, including five (5) women, during a night patrol around Essalu community in Yagba West LGA of Kogi State. The rescued victims were provided with medical aid and handed over to the Patigi Local Government Authority for reunification with their families.

- 🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualties reported/Community residents.
- 🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community members.

🚓 **Description of Incident:** A cattle herder was reportedly shot dead by suspected armed men in an attack at Abuku Dafur Village, in Ribadu Ward, Funakaye LGA of Gombe State. The assailants, numbering about six (6), carted away the victim's mobile phone before fleeing. The motive of the attack is unknown.

🚓 **Location:** Abuku Dafur Village, in Ribadu Ward, Funakaye LGA of Gombe State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One cattle herder dead.

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Mobile phone stolen/Cattle herder.

🚩 **Description of Incident:** A 57-year-old rice farmer was reportedly shot dead by suspected gunmen at Labau Community in Shelleng LGA of Adamawa State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

🚩 **Location:** Labau Community in Shelleng LGA of Adamawa State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Farmer.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the Adamawa State Police Command launched an investigation to identify and apprehend the perpetrators.

 **Title of Incident:** ABDUCTION/ARMED ACTION

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 14/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** A Togolese national was reportedly abducted in an attack by suspected gunmen at Banni Farm Settlement in Ago-Are Community, Atisbo LGA of Oyo State. A joint security team including police operatives, the Amotekun Corps, vigilantes, and local hunters conducted coordinated bush-combing operations and engaged the kidnappers in a gun duel; two (2) suspects were killed, others fled with gunshot wounds, and the victim was rescued.

 **Location:** Banni Farm Settlement in Ago-Are Community, Atisbo LGA of Oyo State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two male suspects dead, one male abducted.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community member, suspected kidnappers.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command intensified efforts to apprehend the fleeing suspects.

Incident N*22:

 **Title of Incident:** DRUG CONTROL ENFORCEMENT/ARREST

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 14/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested 105 suspected drug peddlers in simultaneous raids conducted across various locations in Jigawa State. The operation led to the recovery of over 5,000 illicit substances, including 2,541 units of Exol, 1,146 units of D-5, 270 packets of Tramadol, over 1,000 wraps of cannabis (including one block), 269 units of Diixer, 153 Pregabalin capsules, and 82 units of Farin Malam. Cash amounting to ₦92,460 and other intoxicants such as rubber solution and Dry Gin were also recovered.

 **Location:** Jigawa State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected drug peddlers.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the FCT Police Command reportedly arrested 54 suspects during coordinated raids on black spots, criminal hideouts, and uncompleted buildings across Nyanya, Karu, Kurudu, Life Camp, Apo, Karmo, Zuba, Byazhin, and Bwari Areas in Abuja Municipal Area Council of the FCT.

 **Location:** Nyanya, Karu, Kurudu, Life Camp, Apo, Karmo, Zuba, Byazhin, and Bwari Areas in Abuja Municipal Area Council of the FCT.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected miscreants.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in police custody to undergo screening and interrogation aimed at prosecution.

 **Description of Incident:** Two (2) persons were reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected Fulani militias at Wereng Community in Riyom LGA of Plateau State.

 **Location:** Wereng Community in Riyom LGA of Plateau State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males dead, several people injured.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operatives were deployed to strengthen security in the affected area.

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 14/20/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Security operatives reportedly arrested a 46-year-old male suspect during an operation at Izzam Village in Igabi LGA of Kaduna State and recovered a locally fabricated AK-47 rifle.

 **Location:** Izzam Village in Igabi LGA of Kaduna State

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Criminal suspect.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspect is in the custody of the security agency for further investigation aimed at apprehending his accomplices.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male injured.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community members, herders.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operatives and community leaders are working to identify and apprehend the fleeing suspect.

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 14/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Four (4) police officers under the Adamawa State Police Command were reportedly arrested for alleged indiscipline and excessive use of force while attempting to arrest a suspect at Sabon Gari Quarters in Fufore LGA, Adamawa State. The officers were accused of firing gunshots to effect the arrest, an act described as unprofessional and captured in a viral video.

 **Location:** Sabon Gari Quarters in Fufore LGA, Adamawa State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Three cows dead/Cattle owner, farmers.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command arrested a suspect with efforts ongoing to apprehend two (2) other fleeing suspects.

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK

✚ **Scale of incident:** Medium

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 14/20/2025

✚ **Description of Incident:** Thirteen (13) residents were reportedly killed in attacks carried out by suspected armed gang on Rachas and Rawuru Villages in Barkin Ladi LGA of Plateau State. The incident is an alleged reprisal to the earlier killing of two (2) Fulani women and one (1) boy along Mangu Road in the State.

✚ **Location:** Rachas and Rawuru Villages in Barkin Ladi LGA of Plateau State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Thirteen people dead.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage reported/Community residents.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the security agencies were deployed to strengthen security. Efforts were also intensified by LG authorities to ensure peace and reconciliation among the affected communities.

✚ **Incident N*30:**
