- **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 14/9/2025
- Description of Incident: Four (4) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Tudun Moriki in Zurmi LGA of Zamfara State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Tudun Moriki in Zurmi LGA of Zamfara State
- Casualty [Male&female]: Four males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/farmers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives were deployed to rescue the abducted and forestall further attacks in the area.

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ROBBERY**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 14/9/2025
