- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 28/9/2025
- ♣ Description of Incident: Suspected armed bandits reportedly abducted a businessman in an attack at Tsaragi Community in Edu LGA of Kwara State. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Tsaragi Community in Edu LGA of Kwara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/Community resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: Security operatives were mobilized to track down the abductors and secure the victim's release.

### Incident N\*2:

- Title of Incident: BANDITRY/ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 28/9/2025
- Description of Incident: Twelve (12) local vigilantes and hunters were reportedly killed, several others injured, and an unspecified number of residents kidnapped in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Ogbayo Area, Oke-Ode Community in Ifelodun LGA of Kwara State.
- Location: Ogbayo Area, Oke-Ode Community in Ifelodun LGA of Kwara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Twelve males dead, several people injured, several people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/Local vigilantes, local hunters, community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims were taken to the hospital for medical treatment. The operatives of the State Police Command were deployed to strengthen security in the affected area.

## Incident N\*3:

- Title of Incident: DRUG CONTROL ENFORCEMENT/ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 28/9/2025
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly arrested two (2) suspected drug traffickers in a security operation in Lagos State. Multiple consignments of cocaine, heroin, and methamphetamine prepared for export to Europe were recovered.
- Location: Lagos State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected drug traffickers.

- Casualty [Male & female]: One male police operative dead, three police operatives injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/Police operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims were taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Security operatives were deployed to strengthen security in the affected area.
