Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 5/10/2025

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed two (2) suspected Boko Haram/ISWAP terrorists in a security operation conducted to repel an attack by the insurgents at the 3 Battalion (Main) Pump House location in Gamboru Ngala-Kala Balge Road in Ngala LGA of Borno State.

Location: Gamboru Ngala-Kala Balge Road in Ngala LGA of Borno State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two male suspects dead.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected Boko Haram terrorists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorists' activities in the State.

Incident N*2:

Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 5/10/2025

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly recovered 4 live rounds of 7.62mm ammunition, 1 AK-47 magazine, and a motorcycle and destroyed several criminal camps during clearance operations conducted at Tarhembe and Torny Communities in Takum LGA, and Lissam Community in Ussa LGA of Taraba State.

Location: Tarhembe and Torny Communities in Takum LGA, and Lissam Community in Ussa LGA of Taraba State.

Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: Criminal hideouts destroyed/Suspected criminal gangs.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing clearance operation to strengthen security across the State.

Incident N*3:

Title of Incident: CULT VIOLENCE/ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 5/10/2025

Description of Incident: Four (4) people were reportedly killed and three (3) others injured in a clash between rival cult groups at Onireke and Isashi Communities in Badagry LGA of Lagos State. The swift deployment of the operatives of the State Police Command resulted in the arrested of five (5) suspected cultists and recovery of 3 firearms, 52 live cartridges, a vehicle, a laptop, mobile phones, and other weapons.

Location: Onireke and Isashi Communities in Badagry LGA of Lagos State.



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- 🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Four males dead, three males injured.
- 🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents, suspected cultists.
- 🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation aimed at prosecution. Efforts are also ongoing to apprehend other fleeing suspects.

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 5/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** A male resident was reportedly killed and a Village Head abducted in an attack by suspected armed bandits on Rani Ramat Village in Patigi LGA of Kwara State.

🚩 **Location:** Rani Ramat Village in Patigi LGA of Kwara State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead, one male

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community members.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operatives were deployed to track down the attackers and rescue the kidnapped village head.

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARREST

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 5/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested five (5) suspects, including three (3) suspected bandits, an informant, and a drug supplier, during a coordinated raid on a criminal hideout at Sabon Birni Area in Kware LGA of Sokoto State. Items recovered include dried leaves suspected to be Indian hemp and various illicit drugs.

🚩 **Location:** Sabon Birni Area in Kware LGA of Sokoto State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected bandits, collaborators.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for investigation aimed at apprehending other fleeing members of the syndicate.

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ABDUCTION/ARMED ACTION

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 5/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Three (3) males were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected Boko Haram terrorists at Malari Village in Konduga LGA of Borno State. The operatives of the Nigerian Army, supported by the State Police Command, CJTF, and local hunters, swiftly responded and repelled the attack.

🚩 **Location:** Malari Village in Konduga LGA of Borno State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three males abducted.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** A coordinated search and rescue operation is ongoing to recover the abducted victims and apprehend the fleeing terrorists.



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Incident N*7:

 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ACTION/ARREST

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 5/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly intercepted two (2) vehicles conveying 120 nylon bags filled with over 3,600 litres of illegally refined Automotive Gas Oil (AGO) along Ikot Okoro in Abak LGA of Akwa Ibom State. Two (2) suspected oil thieves were arrested in connection with the seizures.

 **Location:** Ikot Okoro in Abak LGA of Akwa Ibom State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected oil thieves.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in Nigerian Army custody for further investigation.

Incident N*8:

 **Title of Incident:** BANDITRY/ABDUCTION

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 5/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed, three (3) others injured, and four (4) villagers abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Fakon Idi Area in Jangebe District, Talata Mafara LGA of Zamfara State.

 **Location:** Fakon Idi Area in Jangebe District, Talata Mafara LGA of Zamfara State

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead, three people injured, four people abducted.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army, State Police Command, and local vigilantes responded swiftly, engaging the bandits in a fierce gun duel that forced a retreat. The injured victims were taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

 **Title of Incident:** ABDUCTION

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 5/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Ten (10) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits on a farm at Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime.

 **Location:** Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Ten people abducted.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community members.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operatives were deployed to track down the attackers and rescue the kidnapped village head.

 **Title of Incident:** ARREST

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 5/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Jigawa State Police Command reportedly arrested two (2) male suspects for allegedly stealing gas used to power an Airtel telecommunications antenna in



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Burmanawa Village in Sule Tankarkar LGA of Jigawa State. The suspects were apprehended with an unregistered vehicle and 14 jerry cans used in the theft.

🚓 **Location:** Burmanawa Village in Sule Tankarkar LGA of Jigawa State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected thieves.

🚓 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for investigation aimed at prosecution.

🚓 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested four (4) suspects, including vandals and their suspected buyers, for attempting to dismember towers T297, T298, and T299 along the Mando-Jos 330 kV double-circuit transmission line in Lere LGA of Kaduna State. The suspects had removed tower members, compromising the structures before their arrest.

🚓 **Location:** Mando-Jos 330 kV double-circuit transmission line in Lere LGA of Kaduna State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several towers vandalized/Suspected vandals.

🚓 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for investigation aimed at prosecution. Emergency reinforcement works have also commenced to restore the integrity of the affected towers, while surveillance was intensified to prevent further vandalism.

A Beretta pistol and 1 live ammunition from the suspects.

🚓 **Description of Incident:** A vehicle was reportedly snatched at gunpoint by suspected armed robbers near Hall 2 by the University of Calabar, Calabar Municipal LGA, Cross River State. Following a prompt report by the victim, operatives of the State Police Command intercepted the stolen vehicle at a security checkpoint along the Calabar-Odukpani Road. The suspects, however, escaped arrest.

🚓 **Location:** Hall 2 by the University of Calabar, Calabar Municipal LGA, Cross River State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** One vehicle stolen/Driver, suspected armed robbers.

🚓 **Description of Incident:** The Commander of the Osun State Amotekun Corps, High Chief Dr. Hon. Adekunle Isaac Omoyele, was reportedly injured and his vehicle damaged with bullets in an attack carried out by suspected gunmen along Ikirun Road in Osogbo LGA of Osun State. Later in the night, about fifteen (15) masked men also invaded the victim's private residence as part of a coordinated attack.

🚓 **Location:** Ikirun Road in Osogbo LGA of Osun State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male injured.

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Osun State Amotekun Corps Commander.

🚓 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victim was taken to the hospital for medical treatment. The State Police Command launched an investigation aimed at apprehending the perpetrators of the crime.

🚓 **Date of Occurrence:** 6/10/2025

🚓 **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Rafin-Azum Community in Tafa LGA of Niger State.

🚓 **Location:** Rafin-Azum Community in Tafa LGA of Niger State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males dead.

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

🚓 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command were deployed to strengthen security in the affected area.

 **Title of Incident:** COMMUNAL VIOLENCE/ARSON

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 6/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Three (3) persons including an 80-year-old female were reportedly killed and several properties, including three (3) houses and a rice mill burnt in a communal clash at Taraku Community in Gwer East LGA of Benue State. The violence erupted following the death of a 41-year-old Civil Protection Guard member, whose relatives allegedly launched a reprisal attack that claimed two additional lives.

 **Location:** Taraku Community in Gwer East LGA of Benue State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three people (2 males, 1 female) dead.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Three houses, a rice mill destroyed/Community members, Civil Protection Guard member.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** A joint team of security operatives were deployed to strengthen security in the area while intensifying efforts to apprehend the perpetrators.

Incident N*18:

 **Title of Incident:** PHYSICAL ASSAULT/ARREST

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 6/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested three (3) Egyptian nationals for allegedly assaulting a female campus security personnel attempting to prevent illegal hawking at the University of Calabar Teaching Hospital (UCTH) in Calabar Municipality LGA of Cross River State. A male security staff who intervened and one of the suspects also sustained an injury during the altercation.

 **Location:** Calabar Municipality LGA of Cross River State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males injured.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Egyptians nationals, campus security personnel.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for discreet investigation aimed at prosecution.

 **Title of Incident:** MOB VIOLENCE/HOMICIDE

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 6/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Three (3) suspected kidnappers were reportedly captured and killed by community members at Akabueze camp in Emu Orakwan Community, Esan South-East LGA of Edo State. The suspects were allegedly involved in the killing of a female resident on the 1/10/2025.

 **Location:** Akabueze camp in Emu Orakwan Community, Esan South-East LGA of Edo State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Four people (1 female, 3 male suspects) dead.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community resident, suspected kidnappers.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command commenced an investigation to ascertain the circumstances surrounding the incident.

🚩 **Location:** Northbank Area in Makurdi LGA of Benue State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community member.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operatives were deployed to strengthen security in the affected area, while patrols around Northbank and nearby communities have been intensified to prevent further violence.

🚩 **Title of Incident: DRUG CONTROL ENFORCEMENT/ARREST**

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) reportedly arrested three (3) suspected drug traffickers in a security operation conducted at Riruwai Gate in Doguwa Town, Doguwa LGA of Kano State. 3 sacks filled with Indian hemp (marijuana), were recovered.

✚ **Location:** Zamfarawa Village in Zugu District, Bukkuyum LGA of Zamfara State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Thirty people abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operatives were deployed to track down the attackers and rescue the kidnapped victims.

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 7/10/2025

✚ **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Federal Capital Territory (FCT) Police Command reportedly arrested seventy-one (71) suspects during coordinated raids on criminal hideouts and black spots across Gwagwalada, Nyanya, Kubwa, Apo, Utako, Life Camp, Karmo, Jikwoyi, Kurudu, and Asokoro Areas in Abuja Municipal Area Council, FCT. The operation targeted uncompleted buildings and criminal enclaves.

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 7/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Three (3) traders of Hausa descent were reportedly killed and several others injured in a violent clash at the New Artisan Market in Enugu North LGA of Enugu State. The violence allegedly erupted after some traders accused a fellow Hausa trader of armed robbery and attempted to stone him to death, prompting a rescue attempt by another group that escalated into a deadly confrontation.

 **Location:** New Artisan Market in Enugu North LGA of Enugu State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three males dead, several people injured.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several shops demolished/Traders.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** In response to rising insecurity, the Enugu State Government has begun demolishing the Hausa quarters within the market, alleging the area had become a hub for armed robbery, kidnapping, and drug-related activities in the State.

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 7/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army, in collaboration with the Department of State Services (DSS) reportedly arrested a suspected kidnap kingpin in a security operation conducted at the Oron-Ibaka Axis in Eket LGA of Akwa Ibom State.

 **Location:** Oron-Ibaka Axis in Eket LGA of Akwa Ibom State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected drug kingpin.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the DSS for investigation aimed at prosecution

Incident N*29:

 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ACTION/BANDITRY

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 7/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed several suspected bandits and injured several others in a security operation conducted at Sabon Garin Kwargaba Village in Wurno LGA of Sokoto State. A soldier and a female resident were however killed and a soldier injured in the ensuing gunduel.
