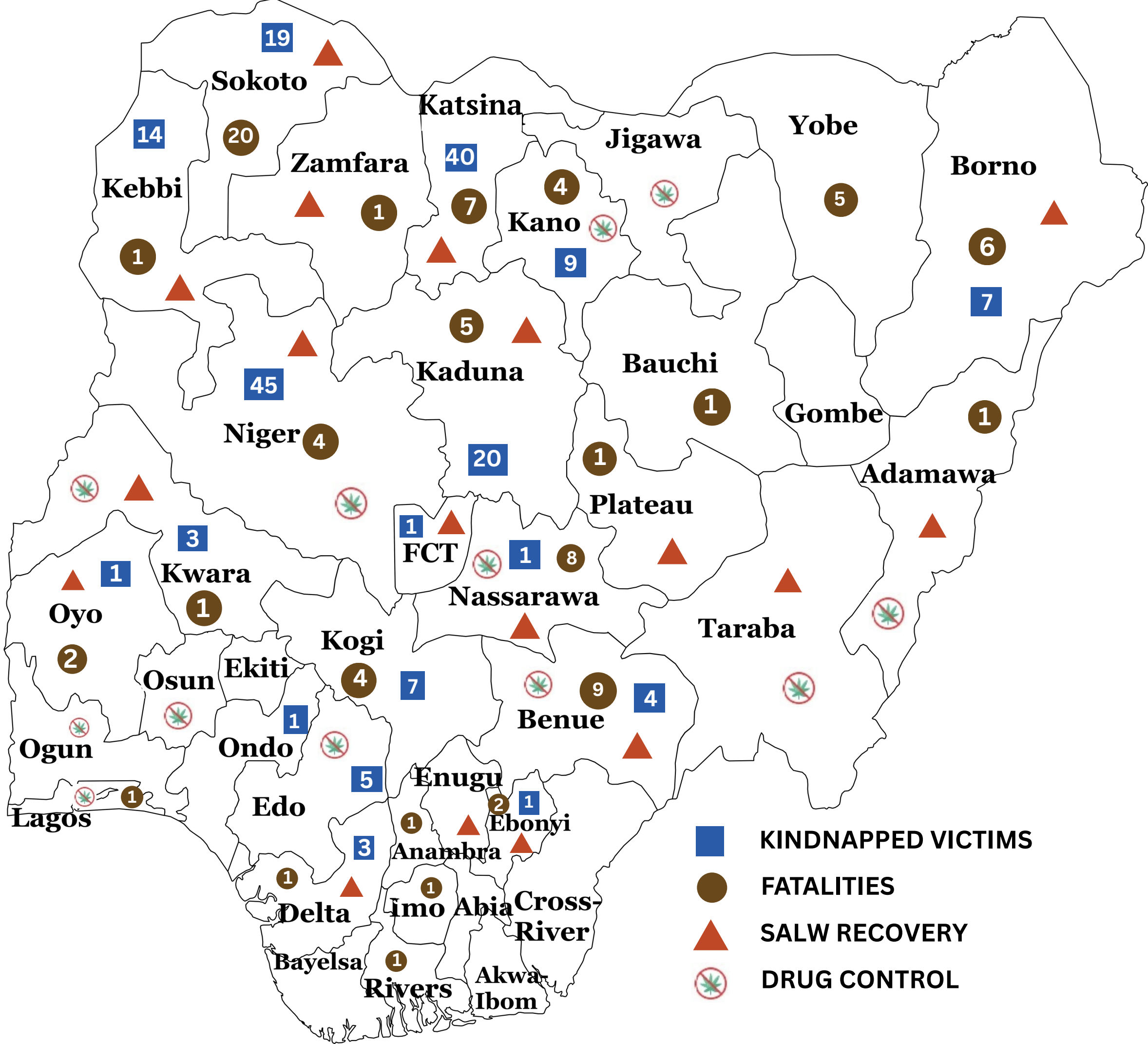
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, and communal clashes including community-herder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

Within the reporting period, a total of 135 armed violence incidents were recorded with 75 injuries and 100 fatalities including 6 women, and 7 security personnel. The North-Central and North-West recorded the highest number of fatalities with 41 and 38, while the North-East and South-East accounted for 13 and 4 deaths. Also, the South-West and South-South recorded 3 and 2 deaths respectively in the reporting period. The period under review recorded a decrease in fatalities (100) compared to the period of October 16-31, 2025 with 132 recorded fatalities. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.

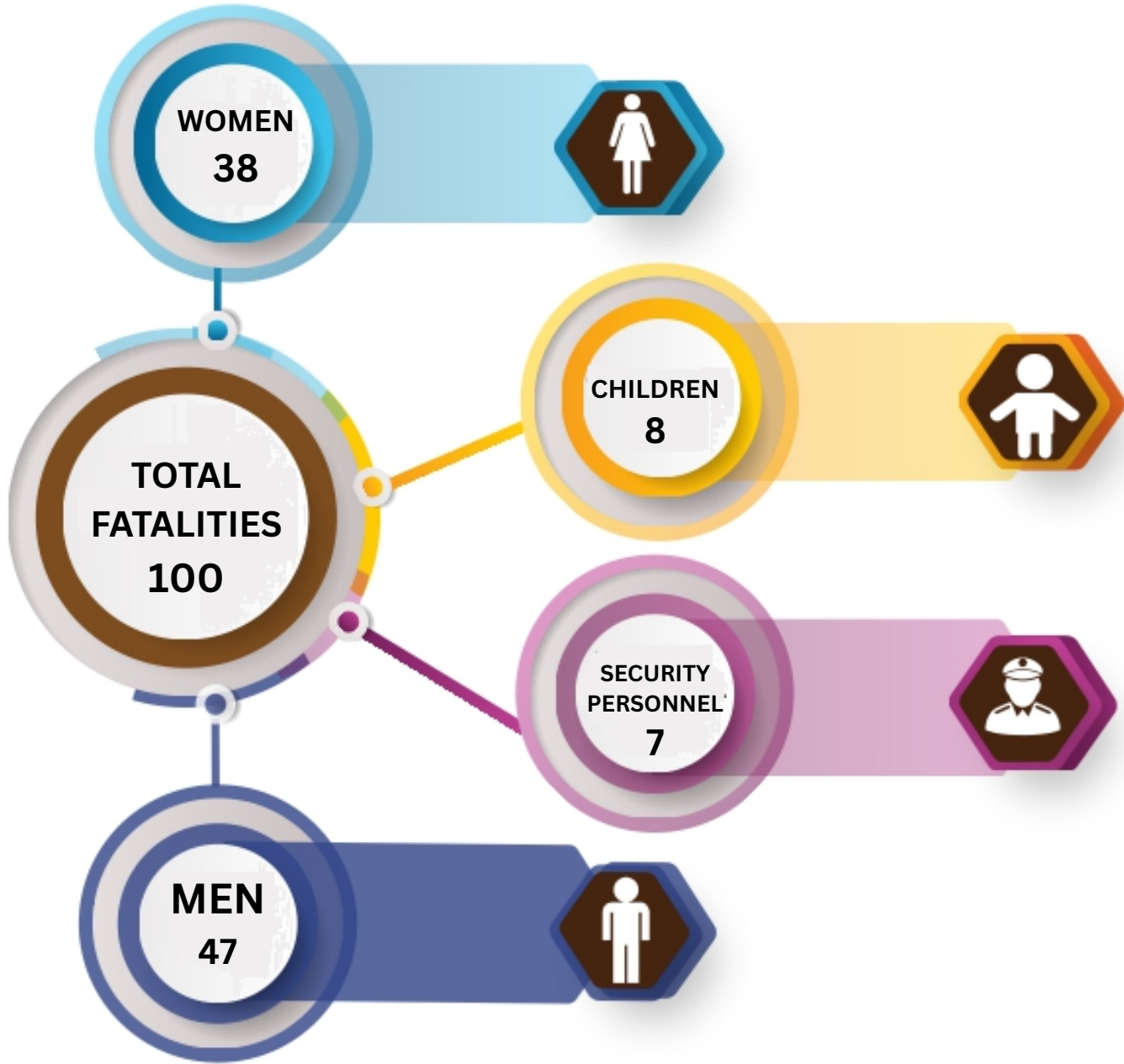
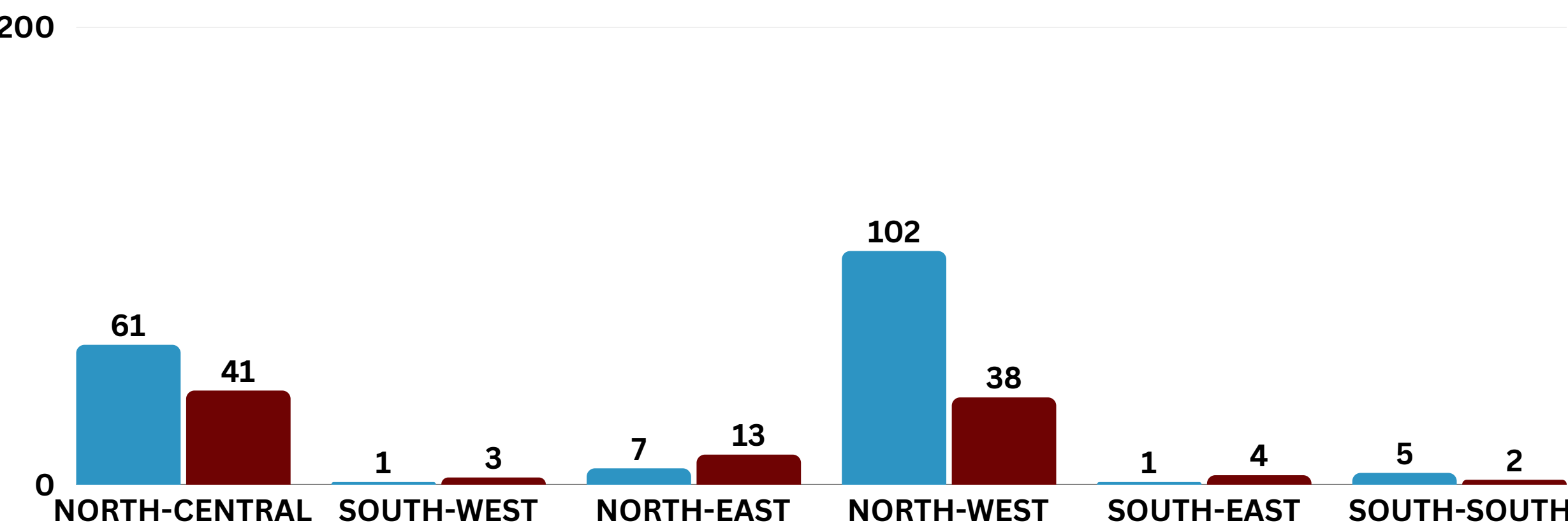
The WANEP NEWS also recorded 34 incidents of kidnapping across 15 States with 177 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 177 kidnapped victims, 38 were women and 8 children. Further analysis reveals that the North-West and North-Central both accounted for the highest numbers with 102 and 61. Also, the North-East, South-South and South-West recorded 7, 5 and 1 kidnapped victims respectively. The South-East had the lowest figure of 1 victim.
