🚩 Scale of incident: Low

🚩 Date of Occurrence: 19/10/2025

🚩 Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested two (2) male suspects in connection with the attack on the Divisional Police Headquarters in Zonkwa, Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State, where two (2) police officers were killed on the 18/10/2025.

🚩 Location: Zonkwa Area in Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State

🚩 Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected criminals.

🚩 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation. Also, efforts are ongoing to apprehend other fleeing members of the gang linked to the attack.

🚩 Title of Incident: ARREST

🚩 Scale of incident: Low

🚩 Date of Occurrence: 19/10/2025

🚩 Description of Incident: Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a male suspect in Giwa LGA of Kaduna State for alleged arms trafficking. The operation led to the recovery of an AK-49 rifle and 200 rounds of 7.62mm live ammunition.

🚩 Location: Giwa LGA of Kaduna State.

🚩 Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected arms trafficker.

🚩 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command and reportedly providing useful information to aid further investigation aimed at apprehending his accomplices.

🚩 Description of Incident: Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested three (3) police officers for alleged involvement in cult-related activities and the unprofessional raid of students' hostels at the Federal Polytechnic Nekede in Owerri West LGA of Imo State.

🚩 Location: Owerri West LGA of Imo State.

🚩 Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Police operatives.



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🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The apprehended officers were detained as the Command commences an investigation into the incident. An Orderly Room Trial of the arrested operatives was also scheduled to begin on 20/10/2025.

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 19/10/2025

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly raided the hideout of a suspected bandit and recovered two AK-47 rifles, one G3 rifle, one revolver pistol, four AK-47 magazines, three G3 magazines, 1,198 rounds of 7.62mm (special) ammunition, four rounds of 7.62mm (NATO) ammunition, three mobile phones at Rawaya Village in Barkin Ladi LGA of Plateau State, following intelligence on the stockpiling of arms and ammunition.

🚩 **Location:** Rawaya Village in Barkin Ladi LGA of Plateau State

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected bandits.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The recovered items are in custody of the Nigerian Army for further action, while efforts are ongoing to arrest the fleeing suspect and his collaborators.

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested four (4) male suspects during an operation conducted at Pompomari Area in Damaturu LGA of Yobe State. The suspects were found conveying a stolen bull in a tricycle. The stolen bull and the tricycle were recovered.

🚩 **Location:** Pompomari Area in Damaturu LGA of Yobe State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Criminal suspects.

Weapons recovered from the scene included a locally fabricated pistol, 5 cutlasses, 1 battle axe, 1 red knife, amongst others.

🚩 **Location:** Akungba-Akoko in Akoko North West LGA of Ondo State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected cultist.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The suspect was detained in custody of the State Police Command while efforts continue to apprehend other fleeing members of the cult group and dismantle the syndicate.

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 19/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Five (5) people were reportedly abducted and several cattle stolen in an attack carried out by suspected bandits at Dinkawa Village in Charanchi LGA of Katsina State. The attack also disrupted movement along the Kano-Katsina Road after Isha prayers.

 **Location:** Dinkawa Village in Charanchi LGA of Katsina State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Five people abducted.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several cows stolen/Community members, commuters.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

Incident N*8:

 **Title of Incident: MOB VIOLENCE**

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 19/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** A commercial motorcyclist was reportedly lynched and set ablaze by community members at Gboko Town in Gboko LGA of Benue State. The victim, who was wrongly accused of stealing a motorcycle, was attacked after losing control of his bike while being mistaken for a fleeing thief.

 **Location:** Gboko Town in Gboko LGA of Benue State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command evacuated the body, with investigations ongoing to identify and apprehend the perpetrators.

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Market in Akpugo community, Nkanu West LGA of Enugu State. A locally made double-barrelled pistol loaded with two live cartridges was recovered from the suspect.

🚓 **Location:** Aku Community in Ankpa LGA of Kogi State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead.

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Herder, suspected hoodlums.

🚓 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command arrested two (2) male suspects in connection with the killing for further investigation.

🚓 **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested two (2) criminal suspects, including a female during a patrol operation at Ubeji Community in Warri South LGA of Delta State. A firearm, a battle axe, a live cartridge, and an expended cartridge were recovered.

The violence, which resumed after a brief truce brokered by community leaders, has spread to farmlands and forests, resulting in the destruction of cocoa plantations and other crops.

🚓 **Location:** Ikom LGA of Cross River State.

🚓 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males dead.

🚓 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Cocoa plantations and other crops destroyed/Community residents.



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🚧 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operatives were deployed to strengthen security in the affected area.

🚧 **Title of Incident:** DRUG CONTROL ENFORCEMENT/ARREST

🚧 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚧 **Date of Occurrence:** 20/10/2025

🚧 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly arrested three (3) suspected cannabis cultivators during an operation conducted at Igbara Odo and Ilawe Ekiti forests in Ekiti State. The operatives destroyed a total of 125,750 kilograms of Cannabis Sativa planted across 29.7 hectares of farmland and recovered 3,456 kilograms of processed cannabis during “Operation Weed Crusher 2025.”

🚧 **Location:** Igbara Odo and Ilawe Ekiti forests in Ekiti State.

🚧 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** 125,750 kilograms of Cannabis Sativa destroyed/Suspected cannabis cultivators.

🚧 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the NDLEA for further investigation.

🚧 **Description of Incident:** Three (3) persons, including a female National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) member, were reportedly injured during a communal clash between residents of Yankwashi Village and Fulani settlers of Yasore in Yankwashi LGA, Jigawa State. The injured victims were taken to the hospital, treated and discharged.

🚧 **Location:** Yankwashi LGA, Jigawa State.

🚧 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three people (2 males, 1 female) injured.

🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community members, NYSC member.

🚧 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift intervention of the operatives of the State Police Command and the Nigerian Army prevented further escalation. Four (4) suspects were arrested, while security patrols and stakeholder engagements are ongoing to maintain peace in the area.

🚧 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Suspected arms courier.

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 21/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Two (2) Nigerian Army operatives were reportedly killed by suspected bandits while repelling a reprisal attack along Marabar Kyaware-Unguwar Chida Axis in Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State. The attack followed the earlier killing of a suspected bandit kingpin and several of his gang members by the troops.

 **Location:** Marabar Kyaware-Unguwar Chida Axis in Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Several people (Two male security operatives, several suspects) dead.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Nigerian Army operatives, suspected bandits.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Security operations have been intensified to counter terrorists' activities in the State.

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 21/10/2025

 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a male Beninese national in possession of a pistol with a live cartridge at Tege Community in Kishi Area, Irepo LGA of Oyo State.

 **Location:** Tege Community in Kishi Area, Irepo LGA of Oyo State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Criminal suspect.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspect was detained in the custody of the State Police Command for investigation aimed at prosecution.

 **Location:** Kujama Community in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead, one security operative injured, eleven people abducted.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage reported/Medical personnel, patients, security guard, NCoS personnel.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured NCoS personnel was hospitalized for medical treatment. The State Police Command launched investigations and search operations to rescue the victims and apprehend the perpetrators.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males dead.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army and the State Police Command were deployed to strengthen security in the affected area. Also, a manhunt is ongoing to apprehend the perpetrators.

Five AK-47 rifles, one PKT machine gun, over 200 rounds of live ammunition, and four empty magazines were recovered.

- 🚧 **Description of Incident:** Five (5) people including four (4) ethnic Fulani residents and an ethnic Nupe male were reportedly killed and several others displaced following a violent clash between Nupe and Fulani communities at Ezhigi Village in Edati LGA of Niger State. The clash began after a Fulani herder allegedly attacked a Nupe man with a machete during an altercation, leading to the man's death. The incident triggered a reprisal attack by Nupe youths, who invaded the Fulani camp and set it ablaze.

- 🚧 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Five males dead.
- 🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

The operatives also successfully repelled another ambush involving an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) attack near Kardio village without any casualties.
