- **Title of Incident: DRUG CONTROL ENFORCEMENT/ARREST**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 26/10/2025
- Description of Incident: Operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly arrested over one hundred (100) suspected drug users and peddlers, including males and females, during a midnight raid at Proxy Night Club, 7 Akin Adesola Street, Victoria Island, Eti-Osa LGA, Lagos State, where cartons of Loud and laughing gas were recovered.
- Location: Proxy Night Club, 7 Akin Adesola Street, Victoria Island, Eti-Osa LGA, Lagos State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected drug users and peddlers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the NDLEA for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

Incident N*2:

- Title of Incident: ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 26/10/2025
- Description of Incident: Operatives of the State Police Command, in collaboration with State Vigilante operatives, reportedly arrested seven (7) suspected cultists during an initiation ceremony in a bush at Obinagu Area in Abagana Axis in Njikoka LGA of Anambra State. A 25-litre keg containing a red liquid substance, red ritual cloth, two wooden drums, and footwear were recovered.
- Location: Obinagu Area in Abagana Axis in Njikoka LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected cultists.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

Incident N*3:

- Title of Incident: COMMUNAL VIOLENCE/BANDITRY
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 26/10/2025
- **Description of Incident:** Ten (10) herders were reportedly killed, and several others injured in a reprisal attack on a Fulani settlement at Tilli Community in Bunza LGA of Kebbi State. The attack was reportedly launched by suspected members of the community following the killing of a vigilante member by suspected Lakurawa bandits.
- Location: Tilli Community in Bunza LGA of Kebbi State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eleven people dead, several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Herders, community members.

Title of Incident: FARMER-HERDER VIOLENCE

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 26/10/2025

- **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed and four (4) others injured in a clash between farmers and herders at Komi District in Funakaye LGA of Gombe State. The altercation reportedly erupted following a disagreement between the two groups.
- Location: Komi District in Funakaye LGA of Gombe State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead, four people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/Farmers, herders.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims were taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Police operatives were also deployed to strengthen security in the affected area.

Incident N*5:

Title of Incident: FARMER-HERDER VIOLENCE

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 26/10/2025

- **Description of Incident:** Nine (9) persons, including five (5) farmers and four (4) herders, were reportedly injured during a violent clash between farmers and herders at Karangiya and Danjawo Villages in Silame LGA of Sokoto State. The clash allegedly erupted over farmland cultivation along cattle routes.
- **Location:** Karangiya and Danjawo Villages in Silame LGA of Sokoto State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Nine males injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/Farmers, herders.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims were evacuated to the hospital for medical treatment. The Chairman of Silame LGA convened an emergency stakeholders' meeting to prevent recurrence, as the Nigerian Army operatives continue intensified patrols and surveillance in the affected communities.

Incident N*6:

Title of Incident: VIOLENT CLASH/VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK

Scale of incident: High

Date of Occurrence: 26/10/2025

- **♣ Description of Incident:** Dozens of suspected terrorists were reportedly killed as Boko Haram's Jama'atu Ahlis Sunna Lidda'awati wal-Jihad (JAS) faction clashed with Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP) terrorists following the alleged collapse of a truce between both factions at Mangari Area in the Lake Chad region, Kukawa LGA of Borno State. The confrontation is largely seen as a reprisal attack over the killing of a JAS commander.
- Location: Mangari Area in the Lake Chad region, Kukawa LGA of Borno State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Several people dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/Suspected JAS, ISWAP terrorists.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: Military operatives were placed on high alert and maintaining operations to prevent infiltration and further terrorist activity in the region.

- Location: Aviara Community in Isoko South LGA of Delta State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected Eiye cult members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects were detained in the custody of the Nigeria Police Force for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

The operation led to the recovery of a single-barrelled gun loaded with a live cartridge from the suspects.
- Location: Amurin Forest in the Owo-Ifon area of Ose LGA, Ondo State.

- **Date of Occurrence:** 27/10/2025
- Description of Incident: One (1) suspected member of the proscribed Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) and its armed affiliate, the Eastern Security Network (ESN), was reportedly killed and several others injured in a gun duel with local vigilantes at Ezinifite Community in Nnewi South LGA of Anambra State. A pump-action rifle was recovered from the deceased suspect.
- Location: Ezinifite Community in Nnewi South LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male suspect dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/IPOB/ESN member.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command cordoned off the area, and joint security operations with vigilantes are ongoing to apprehend the fleeing assailants.

The conflict, which reportedly stems from disputes over rate collections and land ownership among mostly non-native residents, escalated into reprisal attacks following earlier killings in the area.
- **Location:** Camps Two and Four in Akpabuyo and Akamkpa LGAs of Cross River State.

- Description of Incident: A 22-year-old male was reportedly assaulted and left in a coma by three (3) police operatives over allegations of having an affair with the wife of a senior police officer at the 22 PMF Barracks in Ogudu Area, Kosofe LGA of Lagos State. The injured victim was rescued and taken to the hospital for medical treatment.
- **Location:** 22 PMF Barracks in Ogudu Area, Kosofe LGA of Lagos State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male injured.

- Title of Incident: ELECTORAL VIOLENCE/SHOOTING
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 1/11/2025
- ♣ Description of Incident: Police operatives reportedly killed two (2) persons and injured three (3) others in a shooting incident which occurred while attempting to disperse a crowd during a violent clash with youths at the Central Ward in Kontagora LGA of Niger State amid the local government election. The incident occurred after an altercation broke out when a former Niger State Commissioner of Finance attempted to visit polling units outside his registration area, provoking confrontation from youths.
- Location: Central Ward in Kontagora LGA of Niger State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two persons dead, three people injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage reported/Community members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: Election activities in the affected ward were immediately suspended. Security operatives were deployed to strengthen security in the area.
