 Scale of incident: Low

 Date of Occurrence: 9/11/2025

 Description of Incident: Two (2) people including a Federal Road Safety officer were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Asa 1, Otobi Akpa Road in Otukpo LGA, Benue State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

 Location: Asa 1, Otobi Akpa Road in Otukpo LGA of Benue State.

 Casualty [Male &female]: Two males abducted.

 Property damaged/Affected population: Two males killed.

 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives were deployed to rescue the abducted victims and forestall further attacks in the area.
