- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 16/11/2025
- Description of Incident: Two (2) security operatives were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Rogun Village in Kpada District, Patigi LGA Kwara State.
- Location: Rogun Village in Kpada District, Patigi LGA Kwara State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Two security operatives killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/security operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
