- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 30/11/2025
- Lescription of Incident: A Christian cleric, his wife and several worshippers were reportedly abducted by suspected armed bandits in an attack on a Cherubim and Seraphim church at Ejiba Community in Yagba West LGA of Kogi State. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Ejiba Community in Yagba West LGA of Kogi State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Several people abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property destroyed/Church congregation, Christian cleric.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command launched aerial and ground security operations, including a helicopter and anti-kidnapping units, to track the perpetrators and secure the victims' release.

- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 30/11/2025
- ♣ Description of Incident: A male farmer was reportedly abducted by suspected armed bandits during an attack on a farm along Koro Road in Eruku Community, Ekiti LGA of Kwara State. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Koro Road in Eruku Community, Ekiti LGA of Kwara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Farmer.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Police operatives, military personnel, and local vigilante members have been deployed to conduct search and rescue operations, and efforts to secure the victim's release are ongoing.

Another person remains missing. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime. Security operatives and vigilante teams are conducting search and rescue operations in the area.

- Description of Incident: Operatives of the FCT Police Command reportedly killed three (3) suspected armed bandits in a security operation conducted at Gwagwalada Area Council of the FCT. One (1) suspect was also arrested, and recovered items included 3 AK-47 rifles and 3 magazines with 33 rounds of 7.62mm live ammunition. The operation followed credible intelligence of a planned large-scale attack on local communities with the intention of kidnapping residents.
