Title of Incident: ARMED ROBBERY

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 7/12/2025

- Description of Incident: Members of the Benue Buffalos Handball Team were reportedly attacked by suspected armed robbers along Otukpo Road in Otukpo LGA of Benue State while returning from a sporting event. The attackers allegedly injured the driver, and robbed the victims of mobile phones, jerseys, cash, sports footwear, a music player, and other personal items before fleeing the scene.
- Location: Otukpo Road in Otukpo LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Mobile phones, jerseys, cash, sports footwear, a music player, and other personal items stolen/Members of the Benue Buffalos Handball Team.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: Security operatives intensified efforts to apprehend the perpetrators and recover the stolen property.

### Incident N\*2:

Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 7/12/2025

- **♣ Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army, reportedly killed eleven (11) suspected bandits during a security operation conducted at Kurawa Village in Sabon Birni LGA of Sokoto State. The operatives also recovered 8 AK-47 rifles.
- **Location:** Kurawa Village in Sabon Birni LGA of Sokoto State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eleven male suspects dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected bandits.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

# Incident N\*3:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARSON
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 7/12/2025
- **♣ Description of Incident:** A resident was reportedly injured and a house set ablaze during an attack carried out by suspected herders from Guri LGA of Jigawa State on Yelwan Ariri Community in Zaki LGA of Bauchi State. The injured victim was hospitalized for medical treatment.
- Location: Guri LGA of Jigawa State on Yelwan Ariri Community in Zaki LGA of Bauchi State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One person injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** One house destroyed/Community residents.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The personnel of the State Police Command launched an investigation aimed at apprehending the perpetrators of the crime with efforts ongoing to curb cult-related violence in the State.

Title of Incident: BANDITRY/ABDUCTION

Scale of incident: Low

**♣ Date of Occurrence:** 7/12/2025

- ♣ Description of Incident: Five (5) local vigilantes were reportedly killed and six (6) others including two females, two female minors and 2 male minors abducted in an attack by suspected bandits at Gatawa Community in Sabon Birni LGA of Sokoto State. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime. The attackers also rustled several livestock before fleeing.
- Location: Gatawa Community in Sabon Birni LGA of Sokoto State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Five males dead, six people (2 females, 2 female minors, 2 male minors) abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several livestock stolen/Local vigilantes, community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.
