>Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 4/1/2026

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed five (5) suspected Boko Haram terrorists and rescued three abducted victims, with one AK-47 rifle recovered during a security clearance operation in Konduga LGA of Borno State.

Location: Konduga LGA of Borno State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Five suspected terrorists killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: one AK-47 rifles recovered/suspected Boko Haram terrorists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives were deployed to strengthen peace and security in the area.

Incident N*2:

Title of Incident: ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 4/1/2026

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested two (2) suspects over the alleged killing of three women in a renewed communal violence Lamurde LGA of Adamawa State. Twenty-nine (29) rounds of live ammunition, one AK-47 rifle magazine, cash of ₦90,000, and other items were recovered from the suspects.

Location: Lamurde LGA of Adamawa State.

Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: Twenty-nine rounds of live ammunition, one AK-47 rifle magazine, cash of ₦90,000, recovered.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

Description of Incident: Two (2) people were reportedly injured and twenty (20) others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Unguwar Daudu Community, Dukke Ward, Funtua LGA of Katsina State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

Location: Unguwar Daudu Community, Dukke Ward, Funtua LGA of Katsina State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Two people injured,twenty people abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives were deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
