■ **Title of Incident:** BANDITRY/ARSON

■ **Scale of incident:** Low

■ **Date of Occurrence:** 1/2/2026

■ **Description of Incident:** Suspected bandits reportedly attacked a Police Station at Agwara Community in Agwara LGA of Niger State, where they overpowered police officers and set the facility ablaze. The attackers also proceeded to a nearby church, which was burnt down, and abducted an unspecified number of persons.

■ **Location:** Agwara Community in Agwara LGA of Niger State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Several people abducted.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Church building destroyed/Police operatives, community residents.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command confirmed the incident, while security operatives are currently monitoring the situation and conducting security operations in the area.

■ **Title of Incident:** HOMICIDE/ARREST

■ **Scale of incident:** Low

■ **Date of Occurrence:** 1/2/2026

■ **Description of Incident:** A 45-year-old male was reportedly killed in an attack by a suspected machete-wielding assailant following a dispute at Bundila Market in Bundila Village, Gulani LGA of Yobe State.

■ **Location:** Bundila Market in Bundila Village, Gulani LGA of Yobe State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command arrested the suspected perpetrator and recovered the weapon used in the attack for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

■ **Title of Incident:** BANDITRY

■ **Scale of incident:** Low

■ **Date of Occurrence:** 1/2/2026

■ **Description of Incident:** A 32-year-old Civilian Watch (Cwatch) vigilante was reportedly killed in an attack by suspected bandits at Keware Village in Sabuwa LGA of Katsina State.

■ **Location:** Keware Village in Sabuwa LGA of Katsina State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Cwatch vigilante.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Joint operatives of the Nigerian Army, State Police Command and Cwatch patrol teams were swiftly deployed to strengthen security in the affected community.

■ **Scale of incident: Low**

■ **Date of Occurrence: 1/2/2026**

■ **Description of Incident:** Seven (7) commuters were reportedly abducted in an attack by suspected gunmen along the Anyigba-Ankpa Road at Ofejiji Axis in Igalamela Odolu LGA of Kogi State.

■ **Location:** Anyigba-Ankpa Road at Ofejiji Axis in Igalamela Odolu LGA of Kogi State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Seven people abducted.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage reported/Commuters.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Police operatives swiftly deployed to the affected location and rescued four (4) people including a female and two (2) minors with efforts ongoing to rescue the remaining victims and apprehend the perpetrators.

■ **Scale of incident: Low**

■ **Date of Occurrence: 1/2/2026**

■ **Description of Incident:** Five (5) persons, including three (3) females, were reportedly abducted in an attack by suspected bandits on Agwara Town in Agwara LGA of Niger State. Kidnapping for ransom was attributed as the motive behind the crime.

■ **Location:** Agwara Town in Agwara LGA of Niger State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Five people (2 males, 3 females) abducted.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage reported/Community residents.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Joint security teams were deployed to apprehend the perpetrators and rescue the victims.

■ **Location:** Usaja 1, off Ikpakapit, Yakurr LGA, Cross River State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male dead.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Police operatives rescued the perpetrator from community members, arrested him and placed him in custody for further investigation aimed at prosecution.

■ **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army alongside police operatives and Civil Protection Guards (CPG), reportedly foiled a planned attack by suspected armed gang on Anyagba Village in Katsina-Ala LGA of Benue State. A suspect was killed. An AK-47 rifle, 2 magazines, and 3 rounds of 7.62mm live ammunition were reportedly recovered.

■ **Location:** Anyagba Village in Katsina-Ala LGA of Benue State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male suspect dead.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage/Suspected armed gang.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

■ **Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION/LIVESTOCK RUSTLING**

■ **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army alongside other security agencies, reportedly repelled a bandits' attack on Kola Village in Salame District, Gwadabawa LGA of Sokoto State and recovered 48 rustled sheep. The operatives also recovered an AK-47 rifle and 24 rounds of live ammunition.

■ **Location:** Kola Village in Salame District, Gwadabawa LGA of Sokoto State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Forty-eight cows rustled/Community residents, suspected bandits.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

Church members allegedly spotted the object while digging for a new perimeter fence and immediately alerted authorities.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Church members.

- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males abducted.

- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command launched search-and-rescue operations to rescue the victims and apprehend the perpetrators.

The suspects did not possess the required licences or permits for mining activities.

The operation targeted identified bandit camps linked to recent attacks along the Bakori–Guga corridor.

■ **Location:** Shawu-Mununu Forest Axis, Ruwan Godiya Area in Faskari LGA of Katsina State.

■ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Twenty-seven male suspects dead.

■ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Suspected bandits' camps destroyed/Suspected bandits.

■ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

A blood-stained cutlass allegedly used in the assault was recovered from one of the suspects.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspect was detained in military custody for further interrogation.

The assailants reportedly mounted a roadblock, deflated the vehicles' tyres, and set the trailer head ablaze.
